

How to use the Izushi Walking Map

You cannot come across anything by car or bike, things appear because you are walking. The Izushi Walking Map notes an ordinary landscape such as that. This map works in association with "Izushi Oracle" which is at Izushi Tourist Information Office. A stick of bamboo will appear when you shake the written oracle. A hiragana character such as "い (I)" or "ろ (RO)" is written on the stick, so please look for the same character on the map. Once you find the character, set off with the map in one hand. The way is flooded with things that can only be encountered at Izushi. Some of them are things that you cannot discover just by walking forward. Try facing up or looking below you. Mysterious encounters are scattered in various places at Izushi town.

Be sure to take the written oracle home with you.
